

The activities of Telecommunications Regulatory Authority are managed by a Board of Directors. The Board supervises the affairs of the Authority and the exercises of the duties and powers provided for in the Law.

The Board consists of five members, one of whom shall be the Chairman of the Board. For the appointment of the Board members, a decree based on the proposal of the Council of Ministers shall be issued, and such decree shall designate the Chairman of the Board, provided that the necessity of independence of the Authority, in accordance with the provisions of this Law, be given due consideration. The Chairman and the first member are appointed for four years while the other three members will serve a three-year term.

On 9 December 2002, Royal Decree 50 (2002) designated the Chairman and members of the Board.
