Notice of Revocation of the Central Informatics Organisation Internet Service Provider Class License

On 9 January 2011, the Telecommunications Regulatory Authority (“the Authority”) of the Kingdom of Bahrain received a request from the Central Informatics Organisation (“CIO”) to revoke its Internet Services Provider (“ISP”) Class License.

The CIO is a non-profit government organisation that does not provide public telecommunications services nor does it intend to. The Authority is satisfied that the CIO does not require an ISP License.

Therefore upon the request of the CIO the Authority hereby revokes the CIO’s ISP Class License.
