



Notice of commencement of procedure of revocation of Internet Services Provider License (the “License”) granted to Tasameem Establishment for Information Technology (the “Licensee”)

In the three months prior to the date of this Notice, the Telecommunications Regulatory Authority (“**TRA**”) has attempted unsuccessfully on several occasions to contact the Licensee at the following postal and electronic mail addresses:

TRA has also attempted unsuccessfully to contact the Licensee at the telephone number provided by the Licensee in its License application (the “**Application**”).

TRA reminds the Licensee of the provisions of Article 18 of its License, under which the Licensee may change its contact address as stated in the Application provided that it notifies TRA by registered mail with acknowledgement of delivery at least fifteen (15) days before such change takes effect.

As the Licensee has not provided such notice of change of address to TRA, TRA considers the Licensee to be in material breach of Article 18 of its License.

In accordance with Article 15.1 of the License, the License may be revoked, inter alia, in accordance with section 35 of Legislative Decree 48 of 2002 with respect to Telecommunications (the “**Telecommunications Law**”).

Pursuant to section 53 of the Telecommunications Law, TRA hereby requests that the Licensee provides valid contact details to TRA in accordance with Article 18 of the License by no later than **4 p.m.** on **29 March 2007**.

Failure to provide such details to TRA's satisfaction by this deadline will result in TRA issuing an order under section 35 of the Telecommunications Law (the "**Order**"). In the Order, TRA will direct the Licensee to comply with the provisions of the Telecommunications Law and its License, and may also issue a fine.

Failure to pay any such fine or to comply with the directions contained in the Order will lead to revocation of the License. The effect of such revocation will be that all rights and obligations of the Licensee under the License will cease as at the date of such revocation, and the Licensee will no longer be entitled to provide any services under the License.
