

## RFP Queries – 29/07/2010

1. In section Test Methodology – point 10, the TRA mentions Web Browsing tests, could you please specify if these tests actually refer to WAP tests or does Web Browsing include WAP and WEB?

**TRA answer: Web test is expected, WAP can be performed in complement.**

2. Regarding equipment & tools which will be used during the Audit, what are the arrangements for getting the equipment into and out of Bahrain? Will TRA help in any way?

**TRA answer: As stated in the RFP it is the responsibility of the selected bidder to import any testing equipment. TRA will provide reasonable administrative support i.e. Letter for the purpose of the test equipment.**

3. After the audit is done all equipment should be returned to home country, in case more than one audit is needed for a period of 2 years, how would we deal with the equipment? Should we leave the equipment with TRA until the next audit? If yes, would TRA charge against that? If not, are we expected to ship equipment back and forth?

**TRA answer: The bidder shall select the most appropriate solution for test equipment. TRA does have very limited storage space.**

4. Regarding conducting the Audit, are we asked to conduct the audit in any military places or any other places which need permits? If yes, who will issue these permits? Will TRA help in any way?

**TRA answer: Only public places shall be tested and no permit is required.**

5. Are there any roads or avenues in Bahrain that need permits to drive through?

**TRA answer: No permit is required for the purpose of the drive test.**
